

Webstatus survey cookies

EU and EEA privacy legislation require website owners to get consent from visitors to store or retrieve any information on a computer, smartphone, or other device. Websites owned in the EU/EEA region or targeted towards EU/EEA citizens are expected to comply with this legislation.

Userneeds' Webstatus surveys use cookies to limit the number of times the survey will be shown on each device. The cookies store information on the visitors' devices as described below.

Websites running a Webstatus survey should provide visitors with a privacy notification and information about cookies on the website. Userneeds recommends website owners to add the below information to their privacy notification or cookie information page while the Webstatus survey is running.

In the below text, `[survey_id]` should be replaced with the id of the actual survey, which you can get from your Userneeds sales representative.
